



- Room selection is the process of choosing your room for next year. This process is made up of lottery times which are based on your application date and, if applicable, your matched roommate groups.
- Be sure to clear any holds you have with the University as you will not be able to select a room if you have any holds.
- Current residents do not need to make a payment to select a room. All fees for room and board are due in the Fall

HIGHLIGHTS

- To qualify for on-campus housing, you must be enrolled in at least 9 credits and degree seeking.
- First Year students have an option to live in Eileen, Lathrop, Wickersham, Bartlett, or Moore.
- Non-First Year students have the option to live in Eileen, Moore, Cutler, or Lathrop.
- Limited single rooms will be available during room selection.
- Priority is given to roommate groups. Individuals select rooms last and may not be able to retain their current space.

ROOM SELECTION STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1

Use the link emailed to you to access your Housing Portal.

STEP 2

Click Application in the navigation bar. Click "Create Application" or "Continue Application", depending on the status of your application.

STEP 3

Before starting your housing application, you must review and confirm your profile information. Add Emergency and optional Missing Persons Contact. If under 18, please provide a Guardian Contact.

STEP 4

Complete Your Application: Complete each section of the application by answering all required questions. Click the Continue button at the bottom of each page as you complete it to save your work as you proceed.

STEP 5

Complete Your Student Questionnaire. Your answers help match you with compatible roommates.

Set your questionnaire visibility at the top of the page:

Public: Other students can view your responses during the roommate selection.

Private: Only administrators can see your answers.

STEP 6

Submit and confirm your Application.

CONTINUED

STEP 7

Under "Application", click "Additional Docs" and sign your Housing Agreement.

STEP 8

After your application is approved, you can search for, and request roommates. You can also create or join a roommate group.

The designated roommate group leader will select a room during room selection on behalf of the group.

Those who do not have a preferred roommate or prefer a single room can skip this step.

STEP 9

24 hours prior to the start of your room selection lottery, you will be emailed instructions on how to select your Fall/Spring room assignment.

(Please note, keep an eye out for Meal Plan selection instructions. Those who complete these steps by April 6 will be entered into their room selection process.)





Update your preferred email address and telephone number on UAOnline or at the Registrar's Office to ensure you receive information from the Department of Residence Life in a timely manner. Click personal information on UAOnline then click manage your address, email and phone information link. Ensure your contact info is current!
